Resumen:

La presente investigación aborda la importancia de implementar la cultura en programas que se enfocan en el desarrollo sostenible como herramienta de transversalidad para el cumplimiento e implementación de los Objetivos de Desarrollo Sostenible (ODS). Se analiza su incidencia y relevancia en procesos multidisciplinares, a través de la participación de actores de los diferentes sectores de la sociedad, para de esta forma localizar objetivamente cual es el rango de incidencia de la cultura en los proyectos que se desarrollan. Se estudia la forma en cómo se entrelaza la cultura con los ODS, para entender la importancia de su inclusión como cuarta dimensión para el desarrollo sostenible. En este contexto, se da uso a una metodología de índole cualitativa descriptiva.

Abstract:

This research addresses the importance of implementing culture in programs that focus on sustainable development as a transversality tool to meet and implement the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Its incidence and relevance in multidisciplinary processes was analyzed through the participation of actors from different sectors of society, in order to objectively locate what the range of incidence of culture in the projects that are developed was. The way in which culture is intertwined with the SDGs was also studied to understand the importance of its inclusion as a fourth dimension for sustainable development. In this context, a methodology of a descriptive qualitative nature was used.
